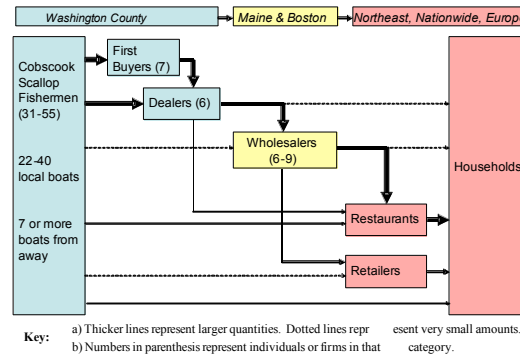

Marketing Cobscook Seafood

Cobscook Bay is home to some of the last good scallop grounds in Maine. A study conducted in 2004-2005 estimated the value of the Cobscook Bay scallop fishery at about \$1 million for that season. The study suggested that opportunities exist to both sell Cobscook scallops to niche markets as a premium product, and to increase sales of Cobscook scallops in local communities. Come talk about what some of these opportunities might be, and hear what other communities are doing to market local food products.
